

MSP vs. MSSP What's the Difference?

Managed Service Providers (MSPs) typically offer server/desktop monitoring and management, data backup and local network and endpoint support for client organizations. At one time, this model was a good alternative to break-fix or on-demand outsourcing, where these services are provided on a more sporadic, as-needed basis.



An MSSP, or Managed Security Services Provider on the other hand offers cybersecurity monitoring and management services in addition to everything a traditional MSP offers.

These services may include virus and spam blocking, intrusion detection, fire-walls and virtual private network (VPN)

management, and more. An MSSP may also handle system changes, modifications and upgrades. However, the key strategic benefit a reliable MSSP can offer is a comprehensive, holistic coverage of all your data security needs.

There are people who do this for a living. This morning, in the period of one minute, there were hundreds of cyber-attacks originating in China, targeting the United States.

What can you do?

Stay vigilant.

1. Visit web sites you know and trust:

This is the simplest and most effective way to keep safe.

2. Keep your web browser and computers up-to-date with the latest patches and security updates:

This is VERY IMPORTANT. While your office computers are kept up-to-date automatically as long as you're covered by any of our maintenance plans, you still need to keep an eye on updates for your home computer(s). Don't ignore these updates!

3. Know web sites you input personal information or credit card information into are secure:

Look at the address bar. If you see "https" you are on a secure web page. If you see "http" you are not on a secure web page.

4. Make web sites you visit more secure:

Browser extensions, such as HTTPS Everywhere, help make web browsing more secure. HTTPS Everywhere takes standard "http" web pages and secures them with "https" by automatically directing you to the secure version of the site. It's not compatible with every web page, but it goes a long way in protecting you.
